#### THE CURONIAN SPIT - A KINGDOM OF WATER, SAND, **AND WIND**

You know that when UNESCO lists somewhere as: "full of unique natural wonders", it must be somewhere special. This narrow sandy peninsula nestled between the Baltic Sea and the Curonian Lagoon is worth seeing, eeling, and exploring. From stunning mountainous dunes to long unspoilt windswept beaches to verdant forest full of mystery and wonder, you'll find all of it here.

## COUNTING **CROSSES**

Whether you find yourself moved by the thousands of personal histories on show or a little overwhelmed by the immensity of it all, there's no doubting that the Hill of Crosses deserves the title of Masterpiece of the Oral and Intangible Heritage of Humanity given by UNESCO. Home to more than 200,000

crosses, this is a place that

will surely blow your mind.

If it's peace and silence that you're looking for, you'll find it here. Right next to the Hill of Crosses, there's a small chapel that was built for the visit of John Paul II and, by it, a Franciscan monastery that's open for pilgrims. You'll not need words here, and that peace you were in search of - you've found it.

#### GET READY TO FIND YOURSELF a spiritual experience

Every year, on the last Sunday of July, during the traditional Indulgence Festival of the Hill, pilgrims carry the cross from the Siauliai Cathedral to the Hill of Crosses. They pray for absolution from sin, creating a spiritual atmosphere that's hard to put into words!

If you're tough enough to face what some might call a creepy night among the crosses, sunrise will reward you with a truly mystical experience. Watch as the dawn brings the light to this sacred and special place and feel the true spirit of Lithuania.

Klaipėda is the country's gateway to the Baltic Sea, but that's just part of its magic. Past the golden sands and inviting sea, there's also the lush green forest that skirts the city's coastline.
